Reminders:

1. After the entry due date of March 30, 2009, we will only accept changes by e-mail up to noon on Wednesday, April 1 (chysong@cox.net).
2. Medals are to be picked up after the meet from the press box. If your team will not be staying through the end of the meet, you can start picking up your medals when you're ready to leave.

Number of Entries Per School:

Each school will be allowed two (2) entries in each individual event. Each school will be allowed one entry in each of the relays. If you have questions, call Dale Nicol or Donna Sollars at 623-412-5430.

Entry Fee:

An entry fee of \$350 is required for each school entering the Kellis Invitational. Checks should be mailed by March 23, 2009. Please make every effort to take care of all paperwork to ensure proper credit. Checks should be made out to Raymond S. Kellis High School.

Awards:

Medals for top three (3) places in each event. Team Trophies for 1st and 2nd Place – Boys and Girls Teams.

Admission:

Admission charge for the public will be \$5.00. AIA passes only.

Scoring:

Top six (6) places will score. Scoring will be 10-8-6-4-2-1

Track Facilities:

The track is a 400 meter all weather surface track. Soft-soled shoes with ¼" spikes or less are required.

Lane Assignments:

The best eight (8) preliminary times will go to finals. Eight (8) lanes will be run in the Boys and Girls High and Intermediate Hurdles.

Shot Put and Discus:

All implements will be weighed underneath the stadium on the Northwest end before 11:00 am.

Pole Vault, Long Jump, and Triple Jump:

The runways for long jump, triple jump, and pole vault are all weather surfaces, therefore, all jumping events will require soft-soled shoes or track shoes with ¼" spikes or less.

Qualifying Meet:

The Kellis Invitational will be a certified meet for 4A and 5A State Meets.
